I would like to take this opportunity to express our heartfelt gratitude for your overwhelming support of the Street School scheme, which has been in operation for the past two weeks. Your appreciation for this initiative has been immensely valuable, and we are indebted to our current volunteers who have kindly dedicated their time to enhance our community.

In order to maintain the morning session, currently running from 8:10 am to 8:50 am, we require additional volunteers. We are keen to sustain this essential service, and to facilitate participation, we can accommodate any school-aged children in our breakfast club while you support the Street School scheme.

As many of you are aware, the afternoon sessions are not presently running; however, we aspire to provide the same safe and nurturing environment that exists in the mornings. We propose to run the afternoon session from 2:50 pm to 3:30 pm, but as it stands, we currently have only one volunteer available for this time slot. If you are able to assist, please know that your school-aged children may attend tea club while you volunteer.

Additionally, I would like to remind you of the parking arrangements during the closure periods. Should you choose to park in the road prior to the closures, it is imperative that you remain in your vehicle until the road reopens. Furthermore, please be mindful that only vehicles displaying a Street School Permit are permitted through the barriers when they are in place. We kindly ask that you do not attempt to pass through the barrier without the appropriate permit.

We are eager to continue this initiative, but it is crucial that we secure more volunteer support to ensure its success. If you feel you can assist, whether in the morning or afternoon, please do not hesitate to get in touch with the school office. Family members are very welcome to volunteer as well.
