Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 2- Art trip to the beach and walk into town

As part of out Art this term the children will become expressive painters. The children will learn that artists explore the world, seeing things around them in new ways, and bring things back to their studios to help them make art. They will also learn that we can go into our own environments, even when they are very familiar to us, and learn to see with fresh eyes and curiosity and that we can use the things we find to draw from, using close observational looking. To help children explore and collect items for this topic, we will be arranging a trip to the beach on Tuesday 8th October. In the morning the children will walk to the beach and spend the morning there. Weather permitting they will also have their lunch on the beach. If the weather is unsuitable the children will return to school to eat their lunch. In the afternoon we will also be taking the children on a walk into town to look at the graffiti in our local area, and visit a local Art gallery. This will be a free trip so no payment will be required.

All children will need a bag (preferably a rucksack containing their packed lunch, additional water and snacks to carry on their backs). Pupils may request a school packed lunch if required, please do this via the class teacher.

Children should wear uniform, but please can your child come prepared for the weather that day, i.e., waterproof coat, sunhat etc. As we will be walking around please ensure pupils have sensible footwear (i.e. trainers).

This trip will prove an excellent experience for the children. Mrs Moyies and Mrs Lodge will be looking for parent helpers to accompany this trip. We plan to leave school at 9.30am and return at 2pm. Please let the office know if you are available to help out on the day.
