Dear Year 4 Parents/Careers.

We are excited to share with you details for a Year 4 activity day and then an optional sleepover at school. The main purpose of this is to give pupils a chance to spend a night away from home with school before residential trips in Year 5 and Year 6, but for pupils to be close enough to home to feel confident.

On Thursday 19th June the activity day will be provided by the Outdoor Education Company (https://www.outdooreducationcompany.co.uk) They are going to bring with them four adventure activities; Skateboarding, Fencing, Aeroball and a large climbing wall.

At Sacred Heart, we are keen to expand the opportunities to pupils, ensuring they get the very best school experience. This day will be an excellent way for your child to develop independence and develop new skills. The activity day will take place during normal school hours and will be on site either outside or in our school hall.

For pupils that choose to stay for the sleepover there will be activities in the evening including bush craft skills, dinner and a campfire. The pupils will be sleeping in the hall on mats and will need to bring their own sleeping bags and pillows. Breakfast will be provided the next morning as well as activities before school. Pupils will then stay in school for the day and collection will be as normal at 3:15pm on Friday 20th June.

The cost of the day's activities are £50, these will be set up in instalments as follows

If your child would like to stay at school for the night, there will be an additional payment of £5 to cover the cost of food and materials for activities. This payment will need to be made to indicate you participation in the sleepover;
